

### Two Kingdoms. Only One Choice.

Although a wide diversity of humanity exists on this earth, the Bible teaches that there actually are only two kingdoms in this world. There is the kingdom of this world, or there is the Kingdom of God, and it is up to the individual to decide which kingdom he or she will be a part of.

The kingdom of this world is governed by one whom the Bible refers to as the god of this world:

**2Co 4:3 But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: 4 In whom the god of this world hath blinded the minds of them which believe not, lest the light of the glorious gospel of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine unto them.**

The god of this world is called Satan, or the devil. Consider what he said when he tempted Jesus:

**Luk 4:5 And the devil, taking him up into an high mountain, shewed unto him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. 6 And the devil said unto him, All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.**

The kingdoms of this world were delivered up to Satan when man willfully sinned against the God Who created all things for Himself. Because of that sin, death, disease, and oppression reign over the inhabitants of the world.

**Rom:5:12 Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:**

**Gen 3:16 Unto the woman he said, I will greatly multiply thy sorrow and thy conception; in sorrow thou shalt bring forth children; and thy desire shall be to thy husband, and he shall rule over thee. 17 And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed is the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat of it all the days of thy life; 18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to thee; and thou shalt eat the herb of the field; 19 In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken: for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.**
